



SKAGIT COUNTY Local Sales Tax Increase

Effective October 1, 2003, local sales and use tax within all of Skagit County will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). This increase was approved by public vote during the April 2003 election. The tax will be used for the purpose of providing funds for costs associated with emergency communication systems and facilities.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the county. Persons or businesses within Skagit County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
