Revenue offers free webinar about taxes for businesses

OLYMPIA – Feb. 13, 2014 – Business owners in Washington have many responsibilities, including knowing which taxes they must report. To help reach more businesses statewide, the Washington State Department of Revenue (Revenue) will host on March 12 a free live webinar for new and small business owners.

This is the first time Revenue has done a business outreach session online. Revenue plans to further leverage the Web to make it easier for businesses by hosting several of these sessions online this year.
