



Clark County Mental Health Tax Effective April 1, 2007

Effective April 1, 2007, sales and use tax within all of Clark County will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for chemical dependency or mental health treatment services.

The sales tax rates for Unincorporated Clark County, the Clark County Public Transportation Benefit Area (PTBA), and the cities of Camas and Yacolt shown below includes the .002 optional tax imposed by the county effective April 1, 2007. Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the county. Persons or businesses within Clark County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.
