



Snohomish County Mental Health Tax Effective April 1, 2009

Effective April 1, 2009, local sales and use tax within all of Snohomish County will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for chemical dependency or mental health treatment services.

The Regional Transit Authority Tax will increase five-tenths of one percent (.005). The tax increase will be used to expand and improve transit facilities in King, Pierce, and Snohomish Counties.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the county. Persons or businesses within Snohomish County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
