

Clark County Transportation Tax Effective April 1, 2012

Effective April 1, 2012, sales and use tax within the Clark County Public Transportation Benefit Area (PTBA) will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for transportation purposes.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within Clark County. Persons or businesses within these areas will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
