

**Cowlitz County Mental Health Tax
Effective April 1, 2013**

Effective April 1, 2013, sales and use tax within all of Cowlitz County will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for chemical dependency or mental health treatment services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within Cowlitz County. Persons or businesses within Cowlitz County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The retail sale or use of motor vehicles, and the lease of motor vehicles for up to the first thirty-six months of the lease, **are exempt from the public safety tax imposed**. Please refer to the Cowlitz County Mental Health Tax Car Dealers and Leasing Companies notice for reporting instructions.
