



PREPROPOSAL STATEMENT OF INQUIRY

CR-101 (June 2004)
(Implements RCW 34.05.310)
Do NOT use for expedited rule making

Agency: Department of Revenue

Subject of possible rule making: WAC 458-16A-100 *Senior citizen, disabled person, and one hundred percent disabled veteran exemption—Definitions.*

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 82.32.300, 82.01.060(2), and 84.36.865.

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: WAC 458-16A-100 contains definitions used to evaluate qualification for the senior citizen, disabled person, and one hundred percent disabled veteran exemption contained in sections RCW 84.36.381 through 84.36.389. The Department is considering revisions to the rule's definitions of "annuity" and "excess levies."
