SOLE SOURCE POSTING

The Department of Revenue (DOR) contemplates awarding a sole source contract to Treinen Associates to provide IT Professional Services in the following categories: IT Project Management; IT Business Analysis and IT Infrastructure Services.

In 2014, DOR entered into a competitively procured contract with Treinen Associates under a Department of Enterprise Services (DES) Master Contract for IT Professional Services which has since been terminated and replaced with a new master contract. The contract was for professional services in support of system design, business analysis and project management for the multi-year Tax and Licensing Systems Replacement (TLSR) Project.

DOR intends to enter into a sole source new work order with Treinen Associates under the new DES ITPS Master Contract to provide ongoing project management, business analysis, and infrastructure engineering support because Treinen Associates professionals already possess familiarity with the TLSR Project, its scope, DOR data structures, other contractors and DOR management, all necessary to ensure the successful implementation of the TLSR Project. Treinen Associates also has the necessary Internal Revenue Service approval to participate on the TLSR Project.

While it is possible that another contractor could develop the same levels of business and system understanding over time, training and obtaining necessary federal approval would be costly and time-consuming, which would negate any financial or business benefit that might otherwise be gained from a subsequent competitive solicitation request.

The contract will be issued on or about November 15, 2016 for 26 months, with no extensions. The dollar value is estimated at \$ 3,740,000, which covers 5 professional staff for 26 months.

Offerors contemplating the above requirements are required to submit capability statements detailing their ability to meet the state's requirements by November 9,

2016, i.e., within five (5) calendar days of this announcement. The following information should be included in the capability statements:

- Knowledge of the DOR legacy tax systems;
- Knowledge of the GenTax solution, specifically the Automated Tax and Licensing Administration System (ATLAS)
- Familiarity with DOR business programs, including business licensing and special taxes

In the absence of other qualified sources, it is the state's intent to make a sole source award of the contract.
