

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

Jefferson County Housing and Related Services Effective April 1, 2021

Effective April 1, 2021, sales and use tax within all of Jefferson County will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for housing and related services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within Jefferson County. Persons or businesses within Jefferson County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
