

City of Ridgefield Transportation Benefit District Effective April 1, 2022

Effective April 1, 2022, the City of Ridgefield will establish a Transportation Benefit District (TBD). Sales and use tax within the City of Ridgefield will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Ridgefield (0604). Persons or businesses within the City of Ridgefield will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
