

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

City of Bainbridge Island Housing and Related Services Effective January 1, 2022

Effective January 1, 2022, local sales and use tax within the City of Bainbridge Island will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for housing and related services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Bainbridge Island (1804). Persons or businesses within the City of Bainbridge Island will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
