City of Mill Creek Local Tax Change Car Dealers and Leasing Companies Effective April 1, 2017

Effective April 1, 2017, sales and use tax within the City of Mill Creek will increase five-tenths of one percent (.005). The tax increase will be used to expand and coordinate light-rail, commute-rail, and express bus service, and improve access to transit facilities in King, Pierce, and Snohomish Counties.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Mill Creek. Persons or businesses within the City of Mill Creek will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.
