

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

City of Port Orchard Transportation Benefit District Effective January 1, 2023

Effective January 1, 2023, the City of Port Orchard will establish a Transportation Benefit District (TBD). Sales and use tax within the City of Port Orchard will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Port Orchard (1802). Persons or businesses within the City of Port Orchard will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
