

City of Liberty Lake Transportation Benefit District Effective April 1, 2024

Effective April 1, 2024, the City of Liberty Lake will establish a Transportation Benefit District (TBD). Sales and use tax within the City of Liberty Lake will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Liberty Lake (3212). Persons or businesses within the City of Liberty Lake will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.
