LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

**Kitsap County
Emergency Communication Tax and
Housing and Related Services
Effective April 1, 2022**

Effective April 1, 2022, local sales and use tax within Kitsap County will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002), except for Bainbridge Island and Poulsbo which will increase by one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for emergency communication systems and facilities and housing and related services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rates of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within Kitsap County. Persons or businesses within Kitsap County will be subject to the new rates of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:

* The .001 tax increase for Housing and Related Services does not apply to Bainbridge Island and Poulsbo, but the cities have imposed the .001 Emergency Communication tax on April 1, 2022.
