3	Open Space Taxation Agreements (OSTA)	<p><i>Assessor's response</i></p> <p>The Assessor's staff reported that in May, the Sauk Suiattle Indian Tribe requested reclassification of the property in question. The county legislative authority passed a resolution amending the Dashiell application to clarify ownership and approve the open space application of the new owner (Sauk Suiattle Indian Tribe). A revised OSTA was prepared.</p> <p>In October, the Assessor's staff checked with the county legislative authority regarding the tribe's response to the revised OSTA. The Assessor's staff received no response. Due to the lack of response from the property owner and the county legislative authority, the Assessor's staff began the removal process.
