A revised OSTA was prepared. In October, the Assessor's staff checked with the county legislative authority regarding the tribe's response to the revised OSTA. The Assessor's staff received no response. Due to the lack of response from the property owner and the county legislative authority, the Assessor's staff began the removal process. The Assessor's staff advised that they are following proper removal procedures. <i>County legislative authority 's response</i> The county legislative authority reported that work on this requirement is not yet completed.
