

### **Notice Regarding Confidential Local Sales Tax Information**

### Secrecy Clause requirement

The local sales tax data your jurisdiction receives contains confidential tax information. The agreement between the Department and your jurisdiction states that "authorized representatives of the City/County requesting and receiving confidential information will sign a Department Secrecy Clause and comply with RCW 82.32.330."

## Confidential information

Some of the data reports you receive will contain confidential tax information (as defined under RCW 82.32.330). For example, the following information is considered confidential information and *may not be shared* with an unauthorized person:

- The amount of sales made by a business
- The amount of sales tax a business reported to your jurisdiction
- Whether a business reported sales tax to your jurisdiction

Confidential information you receive may only be shared with authorized representatives within your jurisdiction who have submitted to the Department a signed Secrecy Clause form.

# Information you can share

The data reports you receive also contain some information that *may be shared* (considered "public information") to any person upon request, including:

- A business's NAICS code
- A business's mailing and/or physical address
- A business's open and/or closed date

### Filing Secrecy Clause forms

If you need to file a Secrecy Clause Affidavit with the Department, you may print the form from the Department's <u>website</u> and return the completed Secrecy Clause Affidavit to the address below.
