1	Assessor Must Complete Statutorily Required Reports by the Due Date	In 2019 and 2020, The Assessor mailed the Notice of Values on or before October 31. Their inspection and valuation work had remained behind schedule causing this delay. Although they are now caught up, they are expecting further delays as they implement Marshall & Swift in 2021. They intend to improve each year and close their roll by 11/15/2021, 10/15/2022, and 9/15/2023. 2	Develop Mass Appraisal Valuation Practices	The Assessor has acquired the Marshall & Swift valuation software for their PACS CAMA system. They are also acquiring desktop versions of Marshall & Swift in order to value manufactured homes.
