# LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

## City of Mount Vernon Transportation Benefit District **Car Dealers and Leasing Companies** Effective April 1, 2017

Effective April 1, 2017, the City of Mount Vernon will establish a Transportation Benefit District (TBD). Sales and use tax within the City of Mount Vernon will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Mount Vernon. Persons or businesses within the City of Mount Vernon will be subject to the new tax rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

### **Special Reporting Instructions for Sales or Leases of Motor Vehicles:**

Businesses that report sales or leases of motor vehicles (for up to the first thirty-six months of the lease) will need to report using the following location code and tax rate. After the thirty-six months of motor vehicle leases, the original city code should be used.

### **Reporting Instructions for Retail Sales:**

Businesses that report retail sales (other than sales or leases of motor vehicles) will need to report using the following location code and tax rate:

Note: The three-tenths of one percent (.003) Motor Vehicle Sales/Lease Tax that was implemented July 1, 2003 still applies to the sale, lease, or rental of motor vehicles.
