

City of Mattawa Transportation Benefit District Effective October 1, 2016

Effective October 1, 2016, the City of Mattawa will establish a Transportation Benefit District (TBD). Sales and use tax within the City of Mattawa will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Mattawa (1308). Persons or businesses within the City of Mattawa will be subject to the new tax rate for reporting use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rate of sales tax is:
