1	Procedure for Adding New Construction at Percent Complete to the Assessment Roll	The Assessor updated their appraiser policies to include adding foundations to new construction as a lump sum if no other work was complete by July 31 st . Construction work that has advanced past the foundation stage is now listed and valued at the percentage complete. The adjustment to the value is calculated using Marshall and Swift percentage complete table. The Assessor provided a copy of their new 2018 New Construction Procedures Manual.	Completed	No
2	Assessor Must Complete Statutorily Required Reports by the Due Date	The Assessor has made significant improvements in getting their statutorily required reports submitted by the due dates. In 2017, they certified their rolls to the BOE on November 2 nd . In 2018, they improved by certifying on October 5th and are hoping to certify their rolls by July 15th this year. When that is complete, they will be further examining the "time of sale" functions that T2 already has and how they can better utilize them.
