Background

- Agency request legislation:
 - A bill DOR drafts and seeks to have sponsored by a state rep. and/or senator
 - Focus on administrative improvements and agency priorities
- Spring: Compile agency request legislation (ARL) ideas from staff and public
- Summer:
 - Whittle down and refine remaining ideas
 - Seek stakeholder feedback
 - Submit to OFM and Governor's office by Sept. 16
 - For consideration, at this time

Inflation Cleanup

Property Tax

- Allows DOR to waive delinquency fee if business doesn't renew business license on time
- Allows DOR to waive late penalty for UCP reports
- Technical corrections
- Restores DOR authority to enter settlement agreements w/ UCP holders

- Port districts' sale of surplus property: \$10,000 → \$22,000
- Annual adjustments to estate tax starting 2024: \$2,193,000 + CPI
- Refinery fuel gas use tax:
 wellhead → Henry Hub
- Hazardous substance tax: clarify existing RCW

- Adds limited times DOR can convert a TP's appeal to BTA from informal to formal
- Provides a 3yr process for taxing districts to recoup a co. assessor's levy error
- Clarifies how assessors should restore regular levies
- Preserves taxing districts' levy capacity when merging
- Technical corrections
