

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

City of Bridgeport Public Safety Tax Car Dealers and Leasing Companies Effective April 1, 2023

Effective April 1, 2023, local sales and use tax within the City of Bridgeport will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for fire protection and public safety purposes.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Bridgeport. Persons or businesses within the City of Bridgeport will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

Special Reporting Instructions for Sales or Leases of Motor Vehicles:

Businesses that report sales or leases of motor vehicles (for up to the first 36 months of the lease) will need to report using the following location code and tax rate. After the first 36 months of motor vehicle leases, the original city code should be used.

Businesses that report retail sales (other than sales or leases of motor vehicles) will need to report using the following location code and tax rate:
