

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

Lewis County Emergency Communication Tax Effective April 1, 2025

Effective April 1, 2025, local sales and use tax within Lewis County will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for emergency communication systems and facilities.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within Lewis County. Persons or businesses within Lewis County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
