

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

City of Longview Public Safety Tax Effective April 1, 2025

Effective April 1, 2025, local sales and use tax within the City of Longview will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for criminal justice purposes, fire protection purposes, or both.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Longview (0804). Persons or businesses within the City of Longview will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The retail sale or use of motor vehicles, and the lease of motor vehicles for up to the first 36 months of the lease, **are exempt from the public safety tax imposed**. Please refer to the City of Longview Public Safety Tax Car Dealers and Leasing Companies notice for reporting instructions.

The new rate of sales tax is:
