

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

City of Vancouver Cultural Access Programs Effective April 1, 2025

Effective April 1, 2025, local sales and use tax within the City of Vancouver will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for cultural access programs.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Vancouver (0605). Persons or businesses within the City of Vancouver will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new rates of sales tax are:
