WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

Island County Emergency Communication Tax Car Dealers and Leasing Companies Effective January 1, 2026

Effective January 1, 2026, local sales and use tax within Island County will increase two-tenths of one percent (.002). The tax will be used for emergency communication systems and facilities.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within Island County. Persons or businesses within Island County will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

Special Reporting Instructions for Sales or Leases of Motor Vehicles:

Businesses that report sales or leases of motor vehicles (for up to the first 36 months of the lease) will need to report using the following location code and tax rate. After the first 36 months of motor vehicle leases, the original city code should be used.

Reporting Instructions for Retail Sales:

Businesses that report retail sales (other than sales or leases of motor vehicles) will need to report using the following location code and tax rate:

The five-tenths of one percent (.005) Motor Vehicle Sales/Lease applies to the sale, lease, or rental of motor vehicles. (This rate increased effective January 1, 2026, per new legislation SB 5814 from .003 to .005.)
