

WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE LOCAL SALES TAX CHANGE

City of Sumner Transportation Benefit District Effective January 1, 2026

Effective January 1, 2026, the City of Sumner Transportation Benefit District will impose an additional one-tenth of one percent (.001) for sales and use tax within the City of Sumner. The tax will be used for transportation services.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services provided within the City of Sumner (2716). Persons or businesses within the City of Sumner will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.

The new sales tax rate is:
