

## Local sales tax change: City of Burlington

### Local Law Enforcement Programs

**Effective April 1, 2026**, local sales and use tax within the City of Burlington, located in Skagit County, will increase one-tenth of one percent (.001). The tax will be used for local law enforcement programs.

Businesses must collect the appropriate new rate of sales tax for retail sales and services. Persons or businesses will be subject to the new rate of use tax on items purchased for their personal or business use if sales tax has not been paid.
