

# Attention out-of-state customers

Starting July 1, 2019, a change in state law requires businesses to collect retail sales tax on purchases by qualified nonresidents who have previously been exempt from paying the tax. This change does not affect merchandise that is delivered to or installed for customers outside Washington, or sales to foreign diplomats or the United States government.

 If you are a qualified nonresident, you may be able to request a refund directly from the Department of Revenue of the state retail sales tax you paid, starting Jan. 1, 2020.

Make sure to **keep your receipts** for verification when you request your refund.
