Sales tax rates to increase in Lacey, Chehalis and Garfield County

OLYMPIA – June 14, 2017 – Consumers in the cities of Lacey and Chehalis, and Garfield County will pay more sales tax on their purchases starting Saturday, July 1.

Consumers in the **city of Lacey** will pay a sales and use tax rate of 8.9 percent. The new sales tax rate includes a two-tenths of one percent increase to help pay for transportation services.

Shoppers in the **city of Chehalis** will pay an 8.2 percent sales and use tax rate. That new sales tax rate includes a two-tenths of one percent increase to help pay for a new transportation benefit district.

The sales tax rate in **Garfield County, including the city of Pomeroy**, will increase by four-tenths of one percent to a new rate of 7.9 percent to help pay for transportation services.
