4	Complete and Timely Filed Petitions	The Department reviewed seven files for the 2017 petition year, five of the files contain the Notice of Value as required. All petitions submitted after July 1 <sup>st</sup> must contain the Notice of Value. One of the petitions does not contain a valid reason for appeal. The reason given on the petition is "Mobil homes do not increase in value at 75% a year. Especially for seniors. This is a senior home park, not a Park Ave home!" This does not offer any reason why the Assessor's true and fair market value is incorrect. The Board must only accept petitions with a valid reason for appeal.
