Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: RCW 82.49.040 requires the Department of Revenue to prepare a depreciation schedule (at minimum annually) for use in the determination of fair market value for watercrafts, which is the basis for measuring the watercraft excise tax. The purpose of this rulemaking effort is to adopt a watercraft excise tax depreciation schedule by rule.
