# **PROPERTY TAX LEVIES DUE IN 2015**

## **Summary**

- Statewide property tax levies due in 2015 grew by 4.4 percent to \$10.307 billion
- County total assessed values grew by 9.3 percent
- Rates dropped, resulting in a statewide average of \$11.70 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

#### **Schools**

School levies include the state school levy assessed for the support of all schools in Washington and local school levies for maintenances and operations, bonds and projects.

- School levies due in 2015 grew by 5.2 percent
- School levy share of all levies increased from 55.5 percent in 2014 to 56.0 percent in 2015
- The state levy increased 2.5 percent to \$2.025 billion
- The state levy represented 35.1 percent of the total school levies
- Local levies increased 6.8 percent to \$3.743 billion
- Local voter-approved excess school levies represented 64.9 percent of the total school levies

#### **Counties**

- County property tax levies due in 2015 grew by 2.9 percent to \$1.651 billion
- County levies represented 16.0 percent of all levies in 2015

### Cities and Towns

- City and town property tax levies due in 2015 grew by 1.4 percent to \$1.310 billion
- City and town levies represented 12.7 percent of all levies in 2015

## **Junior Taxing Districts**

- Junior taxing district property tax levies due in 2015 increased 5.7 percent to \$1.579 billion
- Junior taxing district levies represented 15.3 percent of all levies in 2015
